Consultancy Title: Final Evaluation of BETTER Project in Mozambique

Location: Remote

SUMMARY

CODE (formerly the Canadian Organization for Development through Education) is Canada's leading international development organization focused uniquely on advancing children's literacy and education in sub-Saharan Africa. Over more than 60 years, CODE's programs, delivered in partnership with local civil society organizations, have helped more than 10 million children become more confident and capable readers.

In collaboration with Associação Progresso, its local partner organization in Mozambique, CODE invites proposals for the final evaluation of the *Teacher Training and Empowerment for Results* (BETTER) Project.

BETTER, presently in its nineth and final year, is a project co-funded by Global Affairs Canada (GAC) and CODE, aimed at enhancing pre-service teacher training in Mozambique. Launched in 2015, the project supports four Teacher Training Colleges in Cabo Delgado, Tete, Maputo, and Niassa provinces, with the goal of improving the quality of education for primary school students.

PURPOSE OF THE CONSULTANCY

The final evaluation seeks to assess the project's implementation, identify best practices and lessons learned, and provide recommendations to inform future program design. The evaluation will adhere to the OECD evaluation criteria (Relevance, Impact, Effectiveness, Efficiency, and Sustainability) with a focus on the project's ultimate, intermediate, and immediate outcomes.

SCOPE OF WORK

The evaluation will employ mixed methods, including the review of project documents, key informant interviews, and focus group discussions. Emphasis will be on relevance, coherence,

efficiency, effectiveness, impact, and sustainability. The evaluation team is expected to submit a detailed proposal outlining their approach, methodologies, and team composition to achieve the following deliverable.

- Inception Phase: Desk review, inception report, and work plan by March 15, 2024
- In-country Data Collection: April 10 to May 15, 2024
- Draft Report Presentation: June 15, 2024
- Final Report Submission: July 10, 2024
