You're sparking a reading revolution in Tanzania!

In a groundbreaking literacy initiative made possible by donors like you, CODE partnered with the Children's Book Organization for Tanzania (CBO) to get culturally rich stories into the hands of young Tanzanian readers.

This collaboration has resulted in four vibrant new children's book titles that are now enriching classrooms across Ifakara in the Morogoro Region – and another one is coming soon!


Working with celebrated Tanzanian publishers, CBO has created books that speak directly to children's experiences while meeting the standards of the Tanzania Institute of Education (TIE). These aren't just books – they're gateways to imagination that reflect Tanzanian culture.

The impact is already being felt across 15 schools in Ifakara, where 6,000 books have already found new homes since distribution began in February. Each participating school has so far received 400 books – 100 copies of each title – creating mini-libraries of culturally relevant literature where previously few existed.

This distribution marks more than just the arrival of books – it represents the beginning of a reading revolution in these schools that promises to support improved learning outcomes, one story at a time.


