The Impact Lasts a Lifetime

The first girls who joined CODE's *Girls' Accelerated Learning Initiative* (GALI) in 2018 are now graduating from secondary school, a powerful reminder that investing in girls' education creates opportunities that last far beyond the classroom.

Thank you to every single one of you whose support has made this amazing milestone possible!

Since first launching GALI, more than 3,400 over-age girls have participated, receiving intensive literacy support, life-skills education and encouragement from their communities.

The long-term results are remarkable: 95% (1,956) of girls who could be traced have now completed primary school, while 81% (1,407) of girls from the earliest GALI cohorts are continuing their education in secondary school.

These achievements reflect not only stronger literacy and numeracy skills, but greater confidence, resilience, life skills and opportunity for thousands of young women.

Building on these successes, CODE and our long-term local partner, WE-CARE, have launched REACH Liberia, a new initiative that will extend this proven model to even more girls while strengthening literacy instruction for more than 24,000 children, ensuring this important work continues for years to come.

We look forward to sharing much more in the coming months.
